

EXPECTED STANDARD OF BEHAVIOUR ON SITE COVID-19 SAFE IN 2020

The Derby and Sandiacre Canal Trust can confirm that our return to Working Parties of the Canal Cottages comply with the Government's Guidance of managing the risk of COVID-19 with our volunteers and the general public. Risk Assessments and Method Statements have been created to ensure safe working.

Volunteers will be expected to follow the Expected Standard of Behaviour below.

- Travelling to site. Use your own vehicle, walk or cycle to attend site and only share with another person if they are from your own household. Do not use public transport.
- Wash / sanitize your hand for the recommended length of time upon arrival on site, and before putting on your gloves.
- Report to the site supervisor upon arrival and on leaving site for record purposes.
- Wear gloves at all times. Ensure gloves are cleaned before using and kept clean while working.
- Example 2 Face shields and masks may be required for specific tasks or were Social Distancing cannot be achieved
- Maintain the 2m Social Distancing at all times. Respect other volunteers space. If you get close to someone step away.
- Lone working is not permitted on any DSCT site. However, only work closely with members of your own household or ensure that you maintain the 2m Social Distancing with anyone else you are working with or near.
- Avoid face to face working. Work using side by side or back to back spacing.
- A one way walking / moving material route will be established on site.
- Avoid contact with the general public. Maintain the min. 2m spacing.
- No social gathering on site.
- Ensure that the toilet in Cottage 3 is kept clean. Wash you hands before using, clean the toilet & sink before and after using and wash you hands before leaving.
- Ensure your gloves are clean before putting them back on.
- Were possible, bring your own tools with you to site and do not share. If you use any tool from the 'tool pool' ensure that it is cleaned before and after use and keep it with you while on site. Ensure that any shared equipment is cleaned before and after you use it.
- Wash / sanitize your hand on leaving site.
- Clean any surface that your gloved hand may have touched. Car door handle, your own tools, etc.

Anyone not following the Expected Standard of Behaviour will be asked to leave site.
