1 - Cut around outside edge of template

5 – Nip ends together to form bow

MAKE A CANAL BOAT



To make the canal boat follow these steps...

1. Print off page 1 onto a sheet of white A4 card
2. Cut around the outline of the boat, taking care not to cut off the glue tabs shaded grey).
3. Ask an adult to score along each fold of the house with a ruler and a knife
4. Apply PVA glue or a glue stick to the shaded grey tabs on the walls and floor of the boat.
5. Fold into a boat shape

Why not try...

- You can repeat this several times if you want to make a fleet!
- The boat should be scaled to “OO gauge” so that you could use it with other models like trees, people and trains!
- Make your own template and decorate it as you like!
